



Animal Release Permit

_____(Exhibitor) agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold "The National Recreation and Park Association (NRPA)" its parent, subsidiary, and affiliated companies and their respective officers, directors, employees, and agents and assigns free, clear, and harmless from any and all claims, demands, losses, liability, judgments, liens, costs, and expenses (including reasonable attorney fees) arising out of or in connection with NRPA's agreement to allow _____(Organization) to bring and/or display an animal during the NRPA Annual Conference at the Orange County Convention Center will be dictated by the Legal and Risk Management departments at their sole discretion.

OCCC ANIMAL POLICY

Animals are not permitted on the premises of the OCCC, except in conjunction with an approved exhibit, or in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act as a service animal trained to do work or perform tasks for the benefit of an individual with a disability.

Animals approved to be on the premises must meet the following confinement guidelines:

1. Animal(s) must be on a leash or confined to a pen at all times.
2. Animal(s) must be under constant control and are the responsibility of the owner or handler.
3. Animal exhibits are not permitted on carpeted OCCC areas.

OCCC Event Management must be notified in advance of any planned animal exhibit and/or any intended general public interaction with live animal displays. A detailed schedule must be provided in advance, outlining the nature of the animal exhibit and all appropriate move-in, show and move-out information.

- The general services contractor will be responsible for the placement, removal, and disposal of any floor covering required to protect the flooring underneath the animal's display area.
- If necessary, any vehicles associated with the move-in/move-out of an animal display will be required to adhere to the OCCC Vehicle Display Guidelines.
- The general services contractor or animal handler/owner will be responsible for the removal of all waste from the animal exhibit area, per OCCC guidelines.
